

## Holidays

The district will observe the following school holidays and will not operate on these days:

1. Sunday;
2. New Years' Day (January 1) ;
3. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January);
4. President's Day (third Monday in February);
5. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
6. Independence Day (July 4) ;
7. Labor Day (first Monday in September);
8. Veteran's Day (November 11);
9. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
10. Native American Heritage Day (the day after Thanksgiving); and
11. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday, other than a Sunday, falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be a legal holiday, and whenever any legal holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a legal holiday.

If any of the above-specified state legal holidays are also federal legal holidays but observed on different dates, only the state legal holidays shall be recognized as paid legal holidays.
