Dear Parents,

Emergency situations occasionally arise which may require school schedule delays, closures, or changes in transportation. In the event of a change in school schedule due to weather or emergency conditions, information will be available through Flash alert, the school Facebook page, and the school website at www.bsd46.org. The alert will also be sent to the following local radio/television stations for messaging starting at 6:00 am.

Transportation may be altered in one of the following ways:

1. BRINNON SCHOOL DISTRICT - CLOSED

No buses will run. All school programs and activities for the day are cancelled. **NO HIGH SCHOOL OR OUT OF DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION WILL BE PROVIDED.**

2. BRINNON SCHOOL DISTRICT – THREE-HOUR LATE START

School will start at 11:15. Breakfast will not be served. Buses will attempt to run all routes, but the pickup times will be **3 ½ hours late**.

If buses cannot make individual stops, the school district will attempt to contact parents.

If Mt. Walker is safely passable, high school transportation will be provided on this delayed schedule.

3. BRINNON SCHOOL DISTRICT – THREE-HOUR LATE START WITH LIMITED TRANSPORTATION

South bus run: Will transport students only as far as Black Point. Parents of students beyond Black Point may meet the bus at the intersection of Black Point Road and Highway 101 in the morning at approximately 11:00 am and in the afternoon at approximately 3:30 pm. If Mt. Walker is safely passable, high school transportation will be provided on this delayed schedule.

North bus run: Will transport students only as far as Cove RV. Parents of students beyond Cove RV may meet the bus at the intersection of Bee Mill Road and Highway 101 in the morning at approximately 11:00 am and in the afternoon at approximately 3:30 pm. There will be no transportation to the Upper Lazy C or Rocky Brook Rd.

Additional important weather related information:


- In the event that Quilcene has a late start or unplanned schedule change and Brinnon is on a regular schedule, high school transportation will generally not be provided. Please call the Brinnon School for an update. The District will always provide transportation whenever possible.
- In the case of extreme weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances, we may dismiss and transport students home early. We may also abort or alter a bus run that is already in progress. We will make every attempt to notify parents as soon as a decision is made regarding the time of dismissal or aborted route. If no one is home to receive the student, the school will work with the parent to make an alternative plan. **Parents: please make sure the school has current emergency contact information so we can call emergency contacts if we cannot reach you.** School staff will remain at the school until proper arrangements have been made for every child.

Thank you for your flexibility and understanding. In the event of school closures, a make-up day is scheduled for January 29, 2024. Any additional days will be added to the end of the school year in June.
